

Holiday Beach Conservation Area

Driving directions from Windsor

Take Howard Ave (County Rd 9) South to its end approximately 21 km. Turn right (West) on County Rd 20, go 2.6 km. Turn left (South) on County Rd 50, go 2 km. As you go around the curve, you will see the entrance to Holiday Beach on the South side.

Driving directions from 401

Take the 401 to its western end and exit at Howard Ave, turn left (South) on Howard (County Rd 9), go to its end, approximately 21 km. Turn right (West) on County Rd 20, go 2.6 km. Turn left (South) on County Rd 50, go 2 km. As you round the curve, you will see the entrance to Holiday Beach on the South side.
